We begin with the Invocation, the Lord's Prayer, the Apostles' Creed

1. **Catechism**—Small Catechism
 - ❖ Recite the meaning to the entire Small Catechism! All Six Chief Parts.
 - ❖ Recite the OT and NT books.
2. **Explanation Study**—none.
3. **Scripture Study**—Exodus 40:34-38; Matthew 28:16-20; Luke 24:44-49; Acts 2:42-47; Romans 6:15-23
 - ❖ Question: Where does God promise to be specifically?
 - ❖ Question: What is Jesus' promise to His people?
 - ❖ Question: Who does all the work for our salvation? How do we receive it?
 - ❖ What is to be our lifelong response to Jesus' gifts? How is this manifested?
4. **Hymn of the Week**—*none*
5. **Liturgy Study**—The Rite of Confirmation; Reception Practices of the Eucharist
 - ❖ What are we confirming?
 - ❖ Who has the ultimate power in our right confession?
 - ❖ What drives our postures in worship?
6. **Painting for Meditation**—*none*
7. **Psalm of the Week (prayer)**—Psalm 1
